

Direct Schools Admission – Junior Colleges (DSA – JC)

Particulars to get ready for application:

- 1) Personal Particulars (Name, NRIC Number, Date of Birth, Contact Details, etc.)
- 2) Parents' Information (Name, Occupation, Employer, etc)
- 3) Academic Results (Some JCs require PSLE results, common is Sec 3 Year End or Sec 4N Levels and Sec 4 MYE or Sec 5 MYE)
- 4) CCA Records
- 5) Awards and Achievements (Academic and/or Non-academic)
- 6) Interests & Skills
- 7) Personal Statement (optional, focus is usually on how studying in the DSA-JC you have applied for will help you, write about your aspirations, interests and skills and how you can contribute to the DSA-JC)
- 8) Recommendation by teacher/ principal (some JCs just require contact details of teacher/ principal whom the JC can contact)
- 9) Confirm, Submit, Print (Good practice to keep a copy of what you have submitted, especially for the online forms)
- 10) List of other JCs you are applying for under DSA-JC

Things to think through for your DSA-JC application

(I) The area of interest/ talent that you would like to apply for

There will be auditions/ trials/ interviews as part of the selection criteria. If you are applying via CCA, note that you are required to be committed to the CCA for the 2 years in JC.

(II) Personal Statement

Write about your interests, skills (evidence to support) and aspirations. Highlight on how by entering the DSA – JC will help you achieve your aspirations, develop your interests and skills. If this is optional in the form, you are highly encouraged to provide one in your application.
